

How to apply for a Nursery and Primary One place for our September 2024 intake

The application process will open at 12noon on 9th January 2024 and close at 12noon on 26th January 2024.

The parental admissions portal will go live in January and will be accessed through the Education Authority's website: -

www.eani.org.uk/parents/admissions

- Parents will be able to submit their online application form through the portal and upload the documents required. (An applicant must read the published admissions criteria of their listed preferences to find out if any documentation is requested by a school).
- Information on our school criteria will also be available through the EA website.
- During the admissions procedure applications are not considered on a 'first come first served' basis.

An application received after 12 noon on 26th January 2024 will be treated as late.

- In addition to any documents required, applicants must also upload or submit the CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE.
- Any applicant in receipt of benefit defined under the 'Socially Disadvantaged' criterion must provide verification (Nursery only).

Parents must submit all documents in support of their application before 4pm on 31st January 2024.

The Education Authority will open the online Citizen Portal for parents to view the outcome of their Nursery and P1 application on Thursday 25th April 2024.
