We have been advised that all names will be removed from the list on 30 June and we will then receive a new list at the end of August. Until children's names are on the list we will be unable to provide free school meals. If you are entitled, please apply now even if you are not sure if your child will take dinners. If you have difficulties with the online application please contact (90564000) Education Authority — Belfast Region, Free School Meals Department, in the first instance.
