Welcome to February's Nursery Newsletter, this month we will be learning about Dinosaurs. We will learn the names of different dinosaurs, the climates that they lived in and the types of food that they eat. We will also be learning that dinosaurs are now extinct.

During February we will be encouraging children to be able to do the following:

- Become confident in the open plan setting and begin to develop relationships with peers and adults from the other nursery class
- Develop fine motor skills through threading, manipulating playdough, using tweezers to sort objects
- Zip up coat for outdoor play and fix sleeves on coat (if inside out)
- Check if their shoes are on the correct feet when changing shoes after outdoor play
- Use knife to spread butter on bread and crackers
- Begin to become familiar with shapes and be able to identify and match shapes that are the same
- Begin to recognise own name
- Sing along to number songs and join in with counting during these songs e.g. 5 little ducks
