Chatterbox

We are introducing a 'Chatterbox'. The children will take turns to bring the box home and return the next day with an item in the box to show their friends. This is to encourage the children to speak to a larger group of children and answer questions from their peers.

During 11-14th March you will have the opportunity to come and meet with your child's teacher to discuss your child's progress. This is a great opportunity to find out how your child is getting on and we ask that all parents attend these meetings.

Attendance and Punctuality

It is very important that your child attends Nursery **everyday**, unless they are ill. If your child is ill we ask that you send a letter of explanation on their return. Nursery starts at 9am each day (classroom doors open at 8.55am). The Nursery outside doors are locked at 9.05am.

Doors open at 1.15pm in the afternoon and we encourage you to come into the classroom to see what your child has been learning. **All children should be collected by 1.30pm** as teachers are involved in meetings after school.

How you can help us.

Help your child to recognise their name.

Help your child touch count objects as they count.

Talk about events, e.g. A typical day, sequencing these in the correct order. Use positional language e.g. Beside, behind, under etc.
