SPORTS MORNING

UNIFORM

As advised, the uniform shop was open at the end of May and any uniform ordered by the order forms has been sent home. If you have still to purchase uniform, please send in the order form by Friday 14 June. As the school office is extremely busy at the end of June and the start of September it would be appreciated if parents would ensure that all uniform items are purchased by this date.

HATS / SUNSCREEN

In anticipation of warm and sunny weather during June we would advise that children should bring a hat or cap to school to be worn when they are in the playground. If it appears that the sun will be quite strong, parents are advised to put sunscreen on children <u>prior to school</u>.

ANNUAL REPORTS

Annual Reports will be sent home on Wednesday 19 June. Percentage attendance (up to 31 May) is recorded on the Report. Enclosed with the Report will be an extract from the Department of Education leaflet about attendance. You are asked to note that attendance **below 85%** is considered 'very poor' and details are forwarded to the Educational Welfare Department of the Education Authority who collate attendance information to be sent to the Department of Education. The attendance for the <u>full school year</u> for each child is collected through the annual school census.

Please remember to return the reply slip to indicate that you have received and read the report. Parents are invited to make a comment about their child's progress.

CLASSES FOR SEPTEMBER 2019

Details of your child's teacher and room for September will be given with the Annual School Report. The children will have an opportunity on the afternoon of Monday 24 June to meet their new teacher and see their classroom. If for any reason your child will not be returning in September, please advise School immediately so that we have an indication of places available for September.

TERM DATES/HOLIDAY LIST 2019-2020

Attached to the April Newsletter was a sheet which detailed term dates and holidays for 2019-2020. You are asked to note that school will start on Friday 30 August from 8.55am – 12.15pm for P2/P3 children. There will be no dinners or packed lunches. Parents of children starting P1 received details of starting dates and times at the P1 Parents' Intake Meeting. FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Parents of children who are currently entitled to Free School Meals should have received a form by post from the Education Authority to claim for Meals/Uniform Grant for 2019/2020 school year. It is vital that this form is returned to the Education Authority as soon as possible in order that it is processed prior to the new school year. Only one form should be returned by each family, listing the names of all children who are of school age, including those due to start Nursery. We have been advised that all names will be removed from the list on 30 June and we will then receive a new list at the end of August. Until children's names are on the list we will be unable to provide free school meals. If you have not received this form please contact (90564000) Education Authority – Belfast Region, Free School Meals Department, in the first instance. Information about how you qualify to be entitled and forms for new families are available from the School Office.
