SCHOOL DINNERS

Primary 1 children are now staying for dinners and the hall is at full capacity. As there is considerable administration connected with school dinners parents are reminded of the following:

- All dinner money must be paid on a Monday unless the child is absent.
- Dinners are currently £2.60 per day for P1-3, £13.00 per week.
- Free school meals can only be supplied when we have received notification from the Education Authority.
- Special diets due to medical conditions or for religious reasons can be supplied only if an official form has been returned.
- PLEASE DO NOT SEND OLD STYLE £1 OR PAPER £5 OR £10 NOTES as the Post Office is no longer accepting these.
- Please check you have not included euro or other foreign coins in error.
- Please send as little small change as possible.

PUNCTUALITY

Please remember that school starts at 8.55am. A number of children are arriving late on a frequent basis. This is disruptive to the classrooms and makes it very difficult to finalise dinner numbers for the school meals kitchen.

HARVEST

We will be holding our harvest assembly on Thursday 10 October. This year we will be supporting Storehouse which provides food for needy families. We are asking children to bring in some tins of food on Monday 7 – Wednesday 9 October.

ACCESS TO SCHOOL

In the mornings classroom doors remain unlocked until 9.00am. Only parents and children arriving after this time should be using the main front door. Please remember that parents arriving in school through the front door should report to the office at all times. Please do not continue on down through school without making office staff aware that you are on the premises. If you are leaving school through the main door, please ensure children are NOT permitted to press the door access switch.

After half term the pedestrian gates at Dundela Avenue and Wilgar Street will be locked during the school day. Access will be through the pedestrian gates beside the main gate.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Children are all looking smart in their school uniforms and we would like this to continue throughout the year. Please remember that <u>black school shoes</u> should be worn – coloured trainers are not part of the uniform.
